Applying for Rear-Facing Red Flashing Lamps (Vsn 2 – 01 Oct 2024)



Scope: To help roadside rescue and recovery operators and roadside tyre industry operators decide if they

are eligible to use rear-facing red flashing lamps.

Reason: To protect sectors that are permitted to use rear-facing red flashing lamps. To prevent misuse of


rear-facing red flashing lamps which may result in restriction or loss of permitted use.

Important: Only those companies that hold a Vehicle Special Order (VSO) from the DfT can use rear-facing red

flashing lamps.

All operators should additionally comply with the DfT document – 'Guidance for roadside rescue and recovery operators on Orders issued under Section 44 of the Road Traffic Act to fit and use rear-

facing red flashing lamps on breakdown vehicles'
